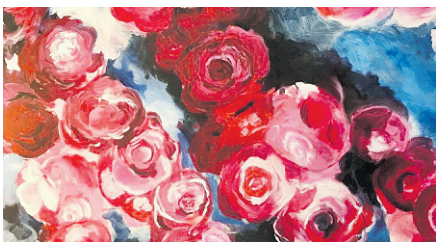
Encourage budding musicians

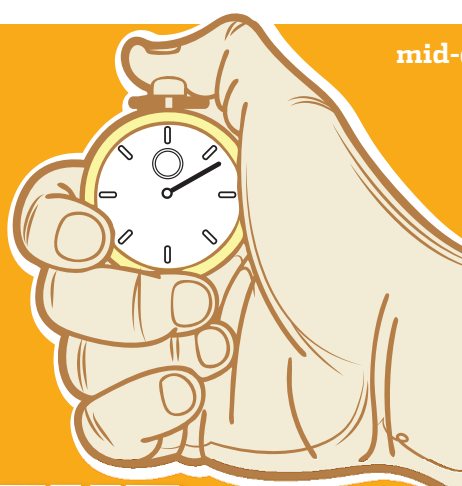

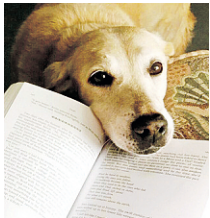
